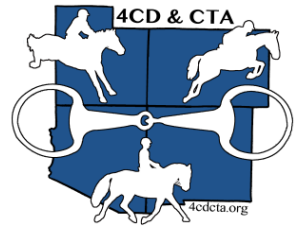

Rider Information

- All riders must be 4CD&CTA members or have paid the non-member insurance fee of \$25.
- **All participants must have a signed release filed with the show office before riding on the show grounds.**
- Non-entered riders are not allowed to ride on the show grounds, unless he/she boards at the facility. This applies to pony rides and letting people "sit" on your horse.
- Junior riders (under 18) must be accompanied by a supervising adult at all times.

Attire:

- **A secured ASTM F-1163 approved helmet is required by all riders while mounted.**
- Appropriate footwear (boot with a heel) is mandatory.
- Show attire is admired, not required. Please dress appropriately for the weather (ie: don't wear a show coat when it is 85+)

Horse Information

- A current (within the last 12 months) negative Coggins test will be required and a copy must be mailed with your entry, or the digital version emailed to the secretary.
- Horses must have been vaccinated for Rhino/Flu in the spring. Proof of vaccination can be provided by a copy of your vet's receipt, the USEF form, or if owner vaccinated proof of such (can be a signed affidavit of vaccination.) It can be mailed with entry or scanned and emailed to secretary. Contact secretary in cases of horses who cannot receive vaccine.
- Horse should be free of lameness and/or communicable health issues. Competitors are asked to check their horse's temperature before leaving for the competition. If it is over 101.5 they should stay home. Competitors may be asked to retire and leave the grounds if this is found otherwise.
- Horses not entered in the show are not allowed on the grounds unless boarded at the facility. There are sometimes exceptions to this, based on facility, but will not be available at our 2016 shows.
- A competitor may be asked to retire if, in the opinion of show management, the mount shows signs of exhaustion.

Permitted Equipment

Equipment must meet requirements as stated in the USEF rulebook (DR121: Saddlery and Equipment.) The only exception to this rule is that hoof boots are permitted. Entries not conforming to the rules will be considered Hors de Concour. The test will be scored, but will not be eligible for placing in the class or year end awards. Some items that do not meet USDF requirements are: bitless bridles, martingales (standing, running and German,) and draw reins. If you plan to use any of these items please state your intention to ride Hors de Concour on your entry. Equipment that results in abuse is not allowed. What constitutes abuse is at the discretion of the show management.

Refunds

We give refunds for any reason up to, and including, the day of the show. The more notice you can give the secretary the better.

Facility Information:

Please be courteous to our hosts by:

- Cleaning up after yourself and your horse
- Not bringing dogs onto the show grounds (not even in your car/truck)
- Educating your spectator friends and family about horse safety and show etiquette.

Our shows are completely volunteer run, so please consider helping us out to keep these shows happening. Contact the show manager if you can help:

- Set up the dressage arena/jumps the day before the show
- Office help the day of the show
- Arena help during the show
- Take down the dressage arena/jumps at the end of the day
- Transport the dressage arena/jumps before and after the show

There will be Year End Awards for volunteers, so if you volunteer make sure your hours are logged with the secretary.

Thoroughbred Incentive Program

All Thoroughbreds registered with The Jockey Club are eligible for TIP High Score award at each dressage show. A copy of the horse's TIP card must be mailed with entry. TIP numbers are free from tjctip.com.

Year End Awards

Horse/rider pair must have at least two scores from Test 3 or B at the same level earned at different shows. The best two will be averaged for the Year End Award Score. The horse/rider pair with the highest score (or lowest for eventing dressage) will win the award. If there is a tie for Year End Awards the pair with the highest cumulative score average will win the award. If it is still tied two awards will be given.
